ITINERARY.

Day 1 | Australia – Copenhagen, Denmark [05-06/07]

Start Our Significant Northern Europe 14 Days tour with overnight flight to Copenhagen, the Capital City of Denmark.

Meals: Lunch and Dinner

Day 2 | Copenhagen [07/07]

Upon arrival in Copenhagen, we proceed to the City Hall and the symbol of the city - the Little Mermaid in Andersen's fairy tale for souvenir photos. Transfer to the port and check in the MSC Euribia cruise ship, the latest 5 star ship of MSC cruises. Night on board.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Day 3 | At Sea [08/07]

1 day at sea! This is your chance to enjoy all the activities and services offered on board. Relax, explore, sport... freely fulfill all your desires! Everything is prepared, enjoy! You can relax and enjoy the sun next to the swimming pool and water park, unless you prefer to relax in a luxurious SPA world. Enjoy the fitness center, beauty salon, sauna... In the evening, many other pleasures are available on board: bars, restaurants, cabaret music and dance stage, casino, etc...

Day 4 | Hellesylt, Norway [09/07]

Discover the spectacular Norang Valley, with its rugged and majestic mountains, during this scenic excursion. The first stop is at the Hellesylt waterfall. Take out your camera to capture this impressive waterfall, before continuing through the Norang valley with its rugged and wild landscape. Admire the scenery frombreathtaking, with a backdrop of rugged, imposing mountains, small lakes and picturesque summer farms.

Enjoy a short stop at Øye, asmall village located at the head of Hjørundfjord, between the Sunnmøre Alps, and which is home to the Union Øye hotel, founded in 1891.

On the way back to the valley of Norang, a photo stop is planned at Lake Lyngstøylvatnet, which originated in a landslide that diverted the course of the river in 1908, forming this lake. Under the waters of the lake, you can still see vegetation, the remains of the old road and farms. Continuing into the valley, enjoy another photo stop at the Ura summer farm, before passing through Hellesylt and making a final stop at Ljøen, offering a splendid panoramic view ofthe Geirangerfjord, a UNESCO heritage site.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Day 5 | Maloy, Norway [10/07]

Untouched nature, beautiful beaches and a rock formation shaped over the centuries by Mother Nature are what you will enjoy during this excursion around Måløy. Leaving the port, you reach your first destination, the Kråkenes Lighthouse. Created in 1906 and surrounded by open sea, the lighthouseboasts numerous wind records and is located in one of the most weather-prone locations on the west coast of Norway, between Ålesund andnorth and Bergen to the south. After a photo stop, you will board the coach and head to Refvik beach. The mile-long white sand long beach is one of Norway's best beaches for swimming and is well worth a short stroll. What will strike you is to discover that allRefvik houses have a thick stone wall on one side to prevent them from being blown out to sea by the strong autumn storms that come down from thevalley. The next destination is a true masterpiece of Mother Nature and is located in Kannestein. This 3 meter high stone sculpture shows thepower of nature itself, the work of a true artist. Kannesteinen does not impress the visitor much if you see it from the sea, but from land,well, it is certainly spectacular and something you will definitely want to capture with your camera. After a break, the return by bus toMåløy and the pier concludes the visit.

Day 6 | Flåm, Norway [11/07]

All the unimaginable shades of green, the invigorating Norwegian air, the superb panoramas of the fjords await you today in the charmingFlam valley on the sides of the Aurlandsfjorden fjord. Your tour will take you on a road that crosses the valley

and which was built to facilitate constructionin 1924 of the main railway which connects Oslo to Bergen. You will walk along the Flam River surrounded by mountains characterized by alush vegetation; you will pass by several farms and admire the marvelous Rjoandefossen waterfalls. Then, you will admire the church of Flam dating back to the 17th century and have free time before going back to the ship.

Day 7 | At Sea [12/07]

Another day to enjoy the ship's facilities and relax.

Day 8 | Kiel, Germany [13/07]

Leave your boat for a few hours to discover Germany's second largest metropolis. From the port, the journey will take you to see theemblematic places of this city renowned for its elegance. On site, immerse yourself in its past by admiring the imposing Saint-Michel Church and strolling through Krameramtsgasse, a charming 17th century alley. Also stroll along the artificial lakes created by diverting the waters of the Alster River,

and in the old quarter of Speicherstadt whose canals will delight you. After lunch at a local restaurant (Included)you will also see the other must-see building of Hamburg such as the City Hall and Docklands. Free time at the vibrant harbor before going back to Kiel.

Day 9 | Copenhagen - Malmo - Stockholm, Sweden [14/07]

After breakfast, disembark your cruise ship and board the coach to head to the charming Nyhavn. The name Copenhagen comes from the words for "Merchant Harbor" for a reason. Nyhavn used to be one of the hubs for the ship merchants of yesteryear. With its colorful facades, Nyhavn is definitely a compulsory stop.

A lance at Amalienborg Palace at noon will give you the chance to admire the Queen's residence at its best with the famous changing of the guard ritual.

After lunch, continue the route to Malmo in Sweeden and explore the spectacular Oresundsbron, the unique bridge-tunnel that connects the 2 Viking countries.

Take the high speed train to Stockholm. Dinner with sandwiches on board.

Night in Stockholm.

DAY 10 | Stockholm [15/07]

Sightseeing of this proud city of canals explores the preserved streets of Old Town, Royal Palace, magnificent blue and gold chambers in Town Hall, and a visit to Vasa Ship Museum. Then, we will embark to a luxury overnight cruise across the Baltic Sea to Finland.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Day 11 | Helsinki, Finland [16/07]

After breakfast, we dock at Helsinki - the Finnish capital. The city's architecture consists of brightly-coloured granite sourced from within Finland's borders, which is why Helsinki is also known as the White City of the North.

Our sightseeing tour will take you to see all highlights of this beautiful city.

You shall visit the 2 best known and emblematic churches of Helsinki: "The white" - Located on Senate Square in the historic center of Helsinki, the Lutheran Helsinki Cathedral overlooks the harbor; "The Red" - Located on the island of Katajanokka, Ouspenski orthodox Cathedral, built from 1862 under Tsar Alexander II.

After lunch at a local restaurant, you will see more of Helsinki with The Senate, Olympic Stadium and Sibelius Monument. Enjoy your free time at the Market Square where all locals like to meet up and relax.

Dinner and night in Helsinki.

Day 12 | Helsinki, Finland – Tallinn, Estonia – Helsinki [17/07]

Tallinn is one of the most beautiful capitals we will visit on our Nordic trip. Stopping in Tallinn, you will immerse yourself in the medieval atmosphere to discover the wonders of the Estonian capital. It has become a leading economic center, as well as an attractive, international metropolis with historical and cultural heritage. Its historic center, with its picturesque cobbled streets and churches and other attractive medieval monuments, has been inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List.

After breakfast at hotel, you will embark Megastar – a symbol of the lastest generation in fast ferry service to cross 50 miles of the Baltic Sea to Tallinn.

Upon arrival at the port, the tour guide will take you to the Old City to explore Upper Street, famous for its watchtowers, arrow-bearing roofs and winding cobbled streets. Walking to the adjacent Kuldjala Tower, we can observe many details of the medieval defensive architecture of the fourteenth century.

After lunch you can enjoy the Lower Street Lower Street with Raeapteek, the oldest pharmacy in the Baltic countries, the house of Congress, merchant houses and the Gothic Town Hall and the 15th century Raekoja Square. Tallinn's newest wonder is a colorful market, the St. Catherine.

Walk back to the port, you will board again the fast ferry for succulent onboard buffet dinner. Night in Helsinki


